This role is responsible for controlling the Selective wave-soldering machine to solder electronic components onto printed circuit boards (PCBs) by performing the following duties:

- Adjusts controls of machines to regulate operating speed and temperature, as well as rails to match board dimensions and spray of flux, and height of solder.
- The right candidate will also have experience in observing meters, gauges, and indicator lights to ensure that soldering of PCBs conforms to processing standards. Experience with hand soldering helpful.
- Assists in maintenance of selective solder machines and equipment.
- Examines samples of soldered boards to detect substandard soldering and discusses this with supervisors and Quality and adjusts accordingly.

This position is also responsible for maintaining and organizing all selective solder machine parts as well.
